The TVPA includes subsection 30.43(2) that prohibits, subject to regulations, the promotion of vaping products, including by means of the packaging, by comparing the health effects arising from the use of the product or from its emissions with those arising from the use of a tobacco product or from its emissions (subsection 30.43 (2)) . This subsection comes into force on 19 November 2018. Health Canada is developing regulations to further implement this subsection in the TVPA, to allow for certain statements to be used in the promotion of vaping products that compare the health effects of vaping to smoking. The proposed regulations would (1) refer to a list of comparative health effect statements that are incorporated by reference in the regulations and (2) prescribe conditions for their use in commercial promotions, including on packaging. The list of permitted statements would be published on Health Canada's website. The use of these statements is not mandated; manufacturers, retailers and others can voluntarily choose to use them in the vaping product promotions as long as they meet the prescribed conditions set out in the regulations for their display.</p>	—
