**GUIDELINES FOR THE PROCESSING OF ICC APPLICATION
via PHILIPPINE NATIONAL SINGLE WINDOW (PNSW)**

TO : ALL STAKEHOLDERS

The Bureau of Product Standards is implementing Department Administrative Order No. 5:2008 - The new rules and regulations concerning the issuance of Import Commodity Clearance under the Product Certification Mark Scheme of the BPS. To further facilitate the processing of ICC application and further reduce processing time and in conjunction with the implementation of the Philippine National Single Window (PNSW) - a program led by the Bureau of Customs, a draft guidelines for the processing of ICC application via PNSW has been developed. This draft guideline is now circulated to all concerned for comments.

All interested parties are invited to comment on the said guidelines. Suggestions requiring revision of the text should indicate the preferred wordings and the relevant clause number should be quoted on any particular comment.
