Examples of these products are multimedia servers.

The purpose of the draft Delegated Regulation, which amends the second subparagraph of Article 3 of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/30, is to defer the application of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/30, so that more time is given to the European Standardisation Organisations to develop relevant complex harmonised standards and to the manufacturers to adapt their products with the state of the art.
