The SNURs require persons who intend to manufacture (defined by statute to include import) or process any of these chemical substances for an activity that is designated as a significant new use by this rule to notify EPA at least 90 days

				before commencing that activity. The required notification initiates EPA's evaluation of the use, under the conditions of use for that chemical substance, within the applicable review period. Persons may not commence manufacture or processing for the significant new use until they have submitted a Significant New Use Notice (SNUN), and EPA has conducted a review of the notice, made an appropriate determination on the notice, and has taken such actions as are required by that determination.
<u>G/TBT/N/U</u> <u>SA/2077</u>	United States	Date of Distribution: 18 December 2023 Deadline for Comments: 13 February 2024	Toxic substances : Tris(2- chloroethyl) Phosphate (TCEP)	The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is announcing the availability of and soliciting public comment on the document titled: "2023 Draft Risk Evaluation for Tris(2- chloroethyl) Phosphate (TCEP)" and related draft charge questions. EPA will be submitting the Draft Risk Evaluation and public comments to peer reviewers who will consider the approach and methodologies utilized. The letter peer review will include review of the analysis of physical-chemical properties, the fate of TCEP in the environment, releases of TCEP to the environment, environmental hazard and risk characterization for terrestrial and aquatic species, and human health hazard and risk characterization for workers, consumers, and the general population. The letter peer review is expected to begin on 13 March 2024, and end on 12 April 2024. A preparatory virtual public meeting will be held on 5 March 2024, for reviewers and the public to comment on and ask questions regarding the scope and clarity of the draft charge questions. Feedback from the letter peer review will be considered in the development of the final TCEP risk evaluation.
