G/TBT/N/E U/1023	European Union	Date of Distribution: 26 October 2023 Deadline for Comments: 24 December 2023	Chemical substances classified as drug precursors	This draft Commission Regulation adds isopropylidene (IMDPAM) and certain esters of two scheduled substances to Category 1 of the list of scheduled substances in Regulation (EC) No 111/2005. Operators will have the obligation to hold a licence for category 1. They will also have special labelling requirements for any packaging containing this substance according to Article 5 of the Regulation.

Thus, in accordance with this regulation, the manufacture of cosmetic products must comply with Good Manufacturing Practices and ETA

G/TBT/N/G BR/69	United Kingdom	Date of Distribution: 27 October 2023 Deadline for Comments: 25 December 2023	Cosmetics products	These measures will amend the Cosmetics Regulation 1223/2009 as applicable in GB ("the Cosmetics Regulations") as they apply in [England, Wales and Scotland]. They will amend permitted levels of certain chemicals in the Cosmetics Regulations. We will be amending the Cosmetics Regulations to permit the use butylated hydroxytoluene (BHT) up to a maximum concentration of 0.1% in toothpastes, 0.001% in mouthwashes and other leave-on oral care products, and 0.8% in all other cosmetic products.
G/TBT/N/U KR/273	Ukraine	Date of Distribution: 25 October 2023 Deadline for Comments: 23 December 2023	Detergents	The draft Resolution provides for the postponement of the introduction of a phased limitation of the content of phosphates and other phosphorus components in detergents used for household and industrial use after the expiration of 90 days following the termination or cancellation of martial law, as well as the exclusion of the provision to carry out the verification of the compliance of the range (model) of a number of detergents or surfaceactive substances according to the requirements of the Technical Regulation for detergents every two years.
G/TBT/N/U SA/1954/A dd.1	United States	Date of Distribution: 25 October 2023 Deadline for Comments: Not Indicated	Hydrofluoroc arbons - Addendum	The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is issuing regulations to implement certain provisions of the American Innovation and Manufacturing Act, as enacted on 27 December 2020. This rulemaking restricts the use of hydrofluorocarbons in specific sectors or subsectors in which they are used; establishes a process for submitting technology transitions petitions; establishes record keeping and reporting requirements; and addresses certain other elements related to the effective implementation of the American Innovation and

Manufacturing Act. These restrictions on the use of hydrofluorocarbons address petitions granted on 7 October
2021, and 19 September 2022.
