This document applies to steel welded gas cylinders designed and manufactured for a nominal working pressure of 2.1MPa and a nominal water capacity up to 150L at normal ambient temperature (- 40 °C ~ 60 °C), and can be repeatedly filled with liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) in accordance with GB 11174.
<a href="#">G/TBT/N/C HN/1763</a>	China	<b>Date of Distribution:</b> 29 September 2023  <b>Deadline for Comments:</b> Not Applicable	Liquefied petroleum cylinder valve	This document specifies the terms and definitions, model establishment, structure type and basic dimensions, technical requirements, inspection and test methods, inspection rules, marking, packaging, storage and transportation of valves for liquefied petroleum gas cylinders (hereinafter referred to as valves). This document applies to valves for liquefied petroleum gas cylinders with service temperature of -40 °C to + 60 °C, nominal working pressure of not more than 2.5MPa and the medium conforming to GB 11174. This document does not apply to valves for automotive LPG cylinders.
