		approved by this Order, may be
		placed on the market for three
		years from the date of entry into
		force of this Order. Such food
		products may be placed on the
		market until the final date of
		consumption or the expiry of the
		minimum shelf life.
		The draft Order developed in
		order to implement EU legislation.
		The draft Order is also notified
		under the SPS Agreement.
