Carrier bags are considered as home compostable in a well-managed system only if all the individual components meet the requirements.  The following four aspects are addressed:  a )Characterization; b) Biodegradation in well managed home composting; c) Disintegration in well managed home composting; and d) Home compost quality.  The four aspects, a) to d), are assessing the effects on the biological treatment process and the compost made by it.
