Worth mentioning is that this standard adopts the technical content of ISO 3183/2019.

This draft notification applies to the following products: 1. Canned liquefied petroleum gas products, which means a product containing gas liquid hydrocarbons, primarily one or a combination of propane or butane, in an aerosol can for a fuel with a capacity not exceeding 1 liter. 2. Portable gas stove products, which means cooking equipment that uses petroleum gas products in canned liquid as fuel. The label of label-controlled goods shall specify the statement, figure, artificial mark, or picture as appropriate, and shall not cause
