
Relative thereto, we respectfully invite stakeholders to comment on the notified draft technical regulations from Chile:

Eliminate the reference to the batch number. It provides that accreditation must be carried out with documentation that covers the regulations in force at the time of the request. It provides the presentation of factory drawings, when the background to be presented does not include them. Provides for the presentation of the test report and factory background in conjunction with the international certification, when the accreditation is covered by United Nations regulations.
