The new regulations will apply in the territory of the MERCOSUR States Parties, to trade between them and to extra-zone imports.

This document applies to oral care and cleansing products, including toothpaste, tooth powder, oral rinses, tooth strips, tooth whitening gel, denture cleanser and other daily products used for human teeth, oral mucosa or denture.
