G/TBT/N/USA/1085/Rev. 1	United States	Date of Distribution: 26 November 2024 Deadline for Comments: 26 December 2024	General service lamps - Revision	Notice of proposed rulemaking and announcement of public meeting (if requested by 2 December 2024) - The U.S. Department of Energy ("DOE") proposes several clarifications to the test procedures for general service lamps ("GSLs") located in appendix W, appendix BB and appendix DD. Specifically, DOE proposes to clarify that GSLs must not be tested as colored lamps, GSLs that can operate at multiple correlated color temperatures ("CCTs") be tested at one specific CCT, and that lamps with additional components that do not affect light output must be turned off during testing.
