Asparagus shoots is classified into four groups according to colour: (a) white asparagus; (b) violet asparagus, having tips of a colour between pink and violet or purple and part of the shoot white; (c) violet/green asparagus, part of which is of violet and green colouring; (d) green asparagus having tips and most of the shoot green.

Cepa group and shallot bulbs grown from Allium cepa Aggregatum group and grey shallots grown from Allium oschaninii O Fedtsch, to be supplied fresh to the consumer. Green onions and green shallots with full leaves as well as onions and shallots intended for industrial processing are excluded. Onions and shallots may be of the following shapes: round, oval/elongated, long or demi-long. Onions and shallots shall have skin colour characteristics of the variety, including white, purple, cream, pink, red, grey, yellow, or brown.

(var.) botrytis; subgroup cymosa (italica) (broccoli) and Brassica oleracea subsp. (var.) acephala; subgroup laciniata, intended for human consumption.

The garlic bulbs may consist of several or only one clove ("solo garlic").
