Under Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009 (the GB Cosmetics Regulation), Government is prohibiting a set of chemicals that have been classified as CMRs under Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008 (the GB Classification Labelling, and Packaging (CLP) Regulation). We will amend technical Annex II to the GB Cosmetics Regulation to reflect the CLP classification.
