Conformity assessment, Environment and environmental protection in general, Electrical and electronic testing, and Lamps and related	This document clarifies test procedures for general service lamps (GSLs), specifying that they must not be tested as colored lamps and that additional components not affecting light output must be turned off during testing. It also provides guidance on testing non-integrated lamps with compatible ballasts or drivers. These clarifications ensure compliance with existing energy conservation standards but do not fulfill the statutory review requirement under the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (EPCA). The rule takes effect on 18 February 2025, with mandatory compliance starting 15 July 2025. Relevant documents are available under Docket Number EERE-2024-BT-TP- 0010 on Regulations.gov.
