Import permits issued before the effective date will remain valid until expiration. During this period, they will be considered preliminary permits for importing alcoholic beverages; 3. Laboratory tests conducted in an Approved Laboratory within the five years preceding the effective date will be deemed valid for obtaining a preliminary import permit. However, their validity will be limited to ten years from the test date; 4. An import permit refers to a permit issued under Order 2.5 of the Director- General of the Ministry of Economy, as was valid before the new regulations and published on the Ministry's website. These provisions aim to facilitate the transition to the new regulations and ensure continuity in import licensing.

This

				rulemaking responds to the Department of the Treasury's February 2022 report on "Competition in the Markets for Beer, Wine, and Spirits," which recommended that TTB revive or initiate rulemaking on alcohol content, nutritional content, and appropriate serving sizes for alcohol beverage labels. Pursuant to its authorities under both the FAA Act and the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, TTB is also proposing mandatory alcohol content statements for certain types of malt beverages, beer, and wine that are not currently required to be labeled with an alcohol content statement. TTB proposes a compliance date of 5 years from the date that a final rule resulting from this proposal is published in the Federal Register.
